What is a Circular Economy?

[vc_column_text] [vc_column_text css_animation="appear"] Circular Economy is a **sustainable economic model** where materials and goods are looped back into the system: it aims to minimise the extraction of raw materials and **eliminate waste**, all while using energy from renewable resources. As opposed to the current linear economic model (*take-make-use-dispose*), a circular economy is **restorative and regenerative by design**. The transition to a Circular Economy requires cooperation of all players involved in the economy (households, companies, public sector), so that one player's waste becomes another's "food" or fuel. The importance of "closing the loop" has been recognised by the European Commission and EU Funds offer a single public-funded opportunity of a coordinated EU-wide transition to a Circular Economy.
